Experience

We are so happy you are joining us for your field trip. Every field trip experience at Lithia Springs Farm is different, because our animals are ever changing. We constantly have babies coming and going. We always want to make sure the field trip students get a special experience on our farm. It can be milking a goat, or collecting eggs and learning how to tell if they are fresh. Certain times of the year we have baby pigs, goats, ducks, bunnies, or chickens. We will make your experience special for the students.

Schedule and Flow of Field Trip

We start by going over the rules and introducing all the workers on the farm. Then we go around and visit each animal, feeding them, brushing them and more. The animals love it just as much as we do! Then head over to the craft tables to do our craft, your students will get to take home. At the end of the field trip, you just collect what you brought. We will worry about trash and other garbage that may get left behind. We do allow you to bring a packed lunch for your students that they can eat at our picnic tables. If you do plan on bringing lunch for your students, just let us know and we will adjust our schedule accordingly. We do have a sink and a bathroom on site. We do ask that you wash your hands frequently to keep you and our animals safe. Field trips typically last 2 hours, if it goes over a little bit, we can accommodate.

Pricing Guide

\$20 per student – chaperones are free.

If a chaperone is bringing a sibling (3 and older), they will also be \$20.

If your group is going to be over 20 students, please contact us to discuss your field trip.



Important to Know

We require a \$100 deposit, at time of booking, to secure your field trip date. The remaining balance due will be collected the day of your field trip.

We do not offer refunds for field trips but will coordinate a rescheduled date with two weeks' notice.

Please have students wear closed-toed shoes and know they might get a little dirty on the farm!

They have a great playground, hiking trail, and natural spring that allows swimming (a separate entrance fee paid to the county is required and if you are swimming, passes are required and often sell out so if you need assistance obtaining these contact us and we can try to assist).
